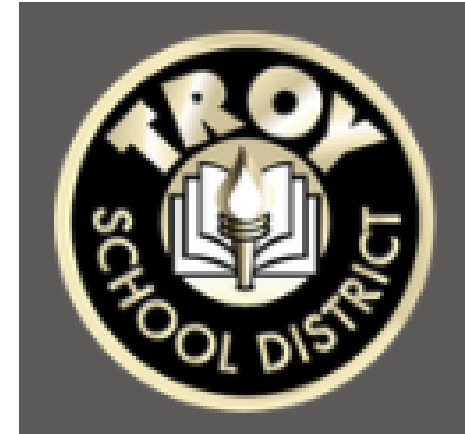
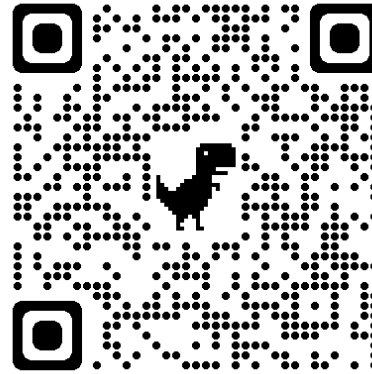

Reflections – Write at least three complete sentences reflecting on this artifact / piece of work.

Consider the following questions / skills to help you:

- What is worth sharing about this artifact?
- Why are you proud of this artifact?
- What were the teacher's expectations or requirements for this artifact?
- Explain how you used certain skills to create this artifact.
- What did you learn through the process of creating this?

Categories – Be sure to categorize each blog post with grade, subject and skill (s).
